We are enjoying meeting people at the Guest House and listening to some awesome experiences. Some of these have been in Africa many years and tell of more primitive times. But each story ends with God’s power and grace through times of difficulty.

Most recently we have a couple here because the wife was hit by a motorcycle and thrown up and landed in the windshield of a car. She has no memory of the accident and she has no broken bones but she is bruised, had a deep cut on her head and feels like all her joints are out of line. She is walking with a walker and is in great pain. Pray for them.

We had another couple here that told stories of times when their house was broken into when he wasn’t home and 2 children were asleep. The mother prayed

that they wouldn’t wake up and they didn’t. They emptied their house but didn’t hurt any of them. Praise God.

We have to young girls from Southern Sudan who run a clinic. There are no roads into their compound – only a small airstrip. They are having tough times with the government there. But finally things were ruled in their favor. God is so good.

We had an Indian mother and son here that were not Christians. Wes had some very good chats with the son and gave him Rick Warren’s little booklet “What on Earth am I here for?” He read it and said “Now I have to digest what I read.” He admitted that it made him think. Pray that the Spirit of God will do a work in him.

Wes & I did the worm pill project again at Mathare & Embakasi Mennonite Schools. Then he preached at Embakasi the following Sunday. Their church is alive and well. There were more men there than at most of the churches.
