

East Coventry Revolutionary Cemetery Memorial Sunday Observance

The graves of East Coventry's seventeen unknown soldiers from the American Revolution will once again be honored on May 28, 2023, at 2pm at Ellis Woods Cemetery. Traditionally held the Sunday of Memorial Day weekend, this will be the 246th year since these patriots began their rest in the tiny plot at Ellis Woods and Buckwalter Roads.

East Coventry Township, Pottstown Joint Veterans Council and Mahanatawny Daughters of the American Revolution invite the public to solemnly observe the sacrifices of our original freedom fighters with a ceremony including public participation, history, music, tradition and non denominational prayers. Street parking along Ellis Woods and Buckwalter will be directed by East Coventry Police and Ridge Fire Company Special Fire Police.

In the event of rain, the event will be held under the pavilion at nearby Ellis Woods Park, 855 Ellis Woods Road, Pottstown, PA 19465.
